The Chaincourt Theatre Company presents two of George F. Walker's *Suburban Motel* one-act-plays this summer semester.

Walker is a Canadian playwright and director from Toronto whose plays have been translated into many languages and have been performed worldwide. *Suburban Motel* was published in 1997 and consists of six self-contained one-act-plays which all take place in a shabby motel room. In 2002 the Chaincourt Theatre Company presented two of the plays. This time the group will present *Problem Child* and *Adult Entertainment*. In *Problem Child* we meet Denise and R.J., whose daughter has been taken away by the youth welfare office and who are now trying to get her back by any means necessary. *Adult Entertainment* revolves around a police investigation which spins completely out of control.
