*The Meaning of Life* – the moment, one thinks about this is the moment one believes it is too late for changes, too late for dreams, too late for love – all that remains is the isolation of everyday life, which waits on one's doorstep every morning. The rest is history.

William Saroyan's stylistically unique play *The Time of your Life* reflects on this moment from many different perspectives using not only text but also music and dance. People from very contrasting walks of life representing the Old and the New World meet on one day in *Nick's Pacific Street Saloon* in San Francisco and reveal their dreams as well as their past desires and ambitions, for which they still sometimes yearn. What makes us happy? Is the fulfilment of our dreams actually a desirable aim or just a welcome escape from our monotonous reality? How much influence do we have on our lives? Are we able to recognise what makes us special?

*The Chaincourt Theatre Company* explores these essential questions in their upcoming production. Under the direction of James Fisk, these themes are presented in a light-hearted, spirited, unexpected, and sensitive way while coming from the heart. We're not immune to our emotions, but perhaps we can realise that every day represents a new chance to reach out for our dreams – that is if we choose to.
